1 Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution :

Following activities have been undertaken by the college which reflect the goals and objectives of the institution.

- Two day workshop on water testing of surrounding water bodies : A two day workshop on water testing of water bodies surrounding Karanja was organized on 6th & 7th November 2009, in order to assess the water quality for potability. The students of the college prior to workshop collected water samples from different water bodies surrounding the city. These water samples were subjected to different tests in the Inter Disciplinary Research Laboratory of the college. This enabled us to know the physico chemical status of the water body. This activity has inculcated scientific temper in the students of the college.
- Blood donation camp : A blood donation camp was organized by the college on 10th November 2009 in collaboration with Government Hospital, Akola as a part of social

activity. During this camp 67 students of the college have donated blood which was deposited in the Government Hospital Akola. The hospital authorities have issued Certificates of Appreciation to the students and staff as a gesture of gratitude.
