1 Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution :

Following activities have been undertaken by the college which reflect the goals and objectives of the institution.

- The college has organized a “Teacher day” function on 5th September 2010. During which Justice Mr. Deshmukh, Diwani Court, Karanja; Justice Mr. Sheikh, Fousdari Court, Karanja; Advocate Mr. Pinjarkar, Advocate Mr. Sumant Bandale, Advocate Mr. Sheikh & Smt. Urmilatai Thakur extended their valuable guidance against prohibition of Ragging and other forms of violence in Educational Institutions Act No. 20 of 1998.
- Department of Computer Science has organized one day workshop on ‘Distance Education under the guidance of Dr. Uday Lohakare, Co-ordinator (distance education centre S.G.B. Amravati University, Amravati) on 17th September 2010.
