2. Student profile – entry level competencies, socioeconomic status, language proficiency etc.,

The Students are admitted to B.Com. programme of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University as per the norms and on first come first serve basis. Any student who has passed H.S.S.C. examination of any stream or discipline is eligible to seek admission in the program.

3. Change made in the courses or programs during the past two years and the contribution of the faculty to those changes.

The Board of studies in commerce of the university prescribes new syllabus after every three years at under graduation level. This change in syllabus was implemented from last year i.e. from the session 2010-11. in the same session for B.Com. I & II. The change for B.Com. III will be implemented from next year. The faculty always keeps abreast of the time and develops various methods of teaching by participating in National seminar, workshop and conferences.

4. Trends in the success and drop out rates of students during the past two years.

The graph of success rate of the students in the university examination is always high. It increased for B.Com. from 65 to 77.59% . the drop out rate reduced for B.Com. from 5.26% to 4.70%. Eight students of B.Com. passed in 1st division in 2010-11. Ms. D.V.Gosar, a students of B.Com. figured in the Merit List of S.G.B. Amravati University, Amravati in the session 2007-2008.

The college has good central library with several titles and multiple copies of the books and national journals and serves as a learning resources of the department.

Though the lecture method dominates teaching other modern methods like group discussion, workshop, seminars are also employed.
