2. Student profile – entry level competencies, socioeconomic status, language proficiency etc.,

All the undergraduate students of faculty of Science, Arts and Commerce are the students of the Physical Education department. The students are admitted from all sorts of socio-economic status regardless of cast, creed, religion and sex. The students showing their proficiency in games and sports are selected according to the merit and enrolled in the team formed for the various inter-collegiate and inter-university competitions special care is taken so that equal opportunity to all the students is provided. The students with excellence in the field of sports are given special privilege and concession in fees at the time of admission. The department strives hard to develop the sports competencies of the students which has resulted into securing several prizes, colour coats and medals.

3. Changes made in the courses or programmes during the past two years and the contribution of the faculty to those changes.

The college is an affiliated college, affiliated to S.G.B. Amravati University, Amravati. During last two years no changes in the rules of the games have been made.

4. Trends in the success and drop out rates of students during the past two years.

The faculty member always encourages students for their participation in various competitions. During academic session 2009-10, 67 students have participated in various competitions. Ms. Shilpa Thakur of our college was included in Volley ball team to represent the university. In academic session 2010-11, 69 students have participated in various competitions at the college and university level. Ms. Shilpa Thakur of B.Com.II succeeded in retaining place in the university volley ball team and participated in all India inter-university tournament held at L.N.U.P.E. Gwalior. She was honoured with silver medal in this tournament. She was also selected for Ashwemedh 2010 tournament held at Akola. Ms. Nikita Sable of B.Sc.III and Kshamanand Nimgade, B.A.II, were selected for Republic Day Parade.

5. Learning resources of the departments - library, computers, laboratories and other resources.

Library :

The learning resources coming under the department of a Physical Education involves different grounds like volleyball ground, kho-kho ground, basket ball court, table tennis hall. The department also has well equipped gymnasium which is made available for other members of the neighbourhood area. The department is well equipped with all sorts of equipments required for the various games and sports. The students are provided special training and can practice regularly, particularly, in evening hours. In order to stress the need of physical education special periods are included in the timetable for physical training.

6. Modern teaching methods practiced and use of ICT in teaching – learning.

The demonstration method is mainly used in training and practice of students. However if needed students can avail facility of free access to the internet which is provided in 'Network Resource Centre'. The department has one computer to carry out the necessary departmental work.

The faculty member continuously motivates the students for the participation in various competitions. By careful observation the students with excellence in particular activity are sorted out & provided personal counseling for the achievement of success. They are provided more attention and given special practice.

The management always extends the hand of co-operation and motivates the faculty members for the participation in faculty development programmes like conferences, workshops, seminars and symposia. In last two academic sessions faculty member participated in two National level, four state level and two university level academic activities.

The main objective of the department is to create better atmosphere in the field of games and sports. To enhance the participation of students and to motivate them to choose games and sports as their career, the department regularly organises various games and sports competitions.
